It is not the experience of TODAY that drives men mad- it is the remorse or bitterness for something which happened YESTERDAY and the dread of what TOMORROW may bring.

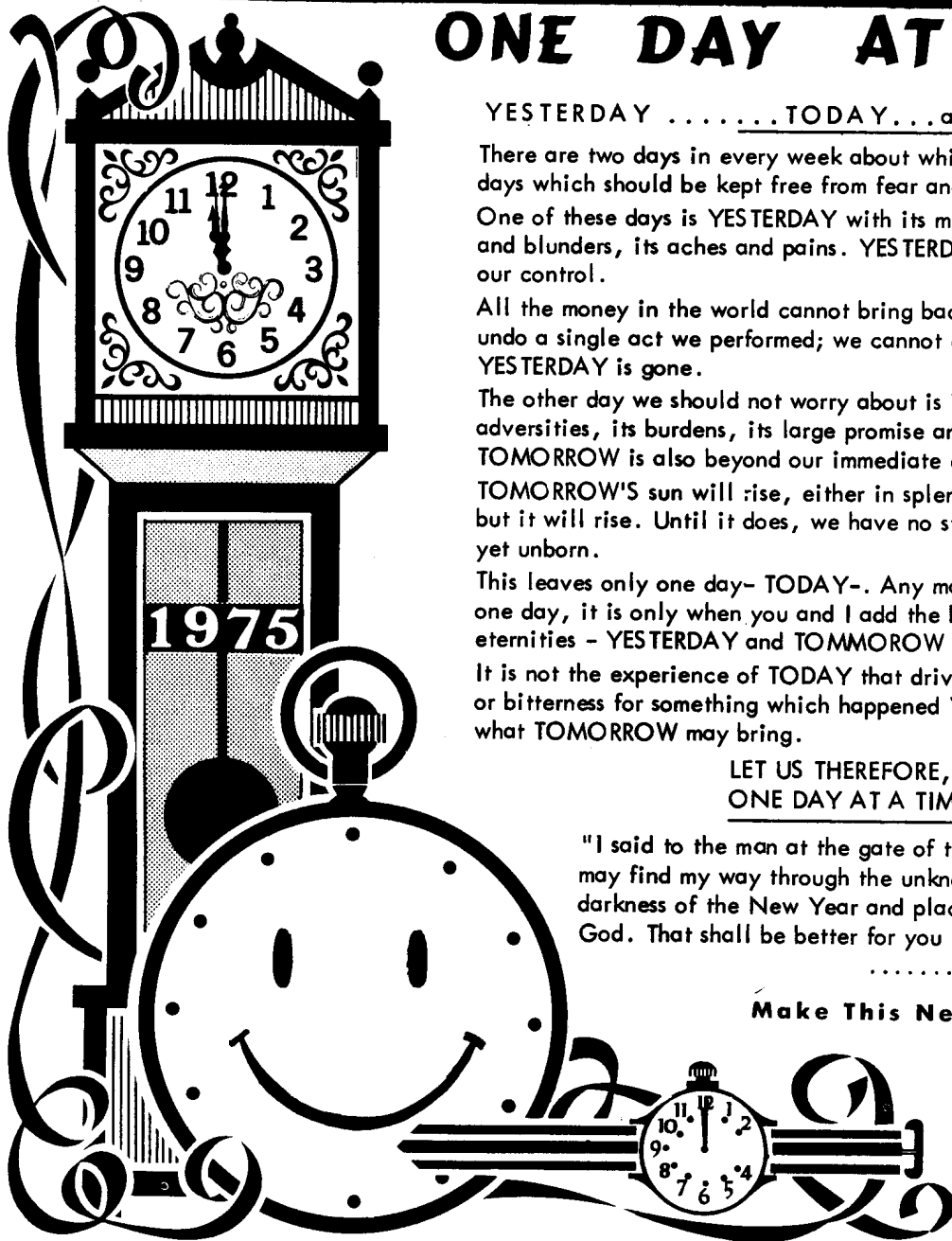

1. I stated I could stop my alcoholic mate from drinking and was master of my life.
2. Believed I was sane and rational in every respect.
3. Decided to run my own life and my alcoholic's and be successful in all my undertakings.
4. Made a searching inventory of the alcoholic, the family and of my fellow man and found them all lacking.
5. Admitted to no one, including myself that there was anything wrong with me.
6. Was entirely ready at all times to blame everything on the alcoholic.
7. Continually told the alcoholic to remove all his shortcomings.
8. Made a list of persons that had harmed me and swore never to forgive them.
9. Got even with such people whenever possible, except when to do so would further injure me.
10. Continued to find fault with the world and the people in it, and when I was right promptly admitted it.
11. Sought through nagging, criticizing, and pouring out liquor to improve the alcoholic, praying only for him to listen to me and stop drinking.
12. After having had a complete moral, physical and financial breakdown as a result of this kind of living, I tried to tell others how hard I tried and continued to practice these reasonings in all my affairs.

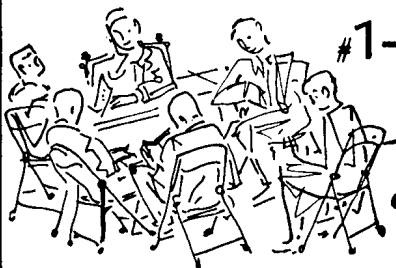

MEMO FROM YOUR DELEGATE.....

JINGLE BELLS AND AULD LANG SYNE tend to distract all of us at this time of year...but your Area officers took a few minutes to look back at the past year's efforts and to give some thought to the year ahead.

Our first and most enthusiastic conclusion was that we are especially blessed with a dedicated, hard-working, cohesive Area Service Committee and General Service Assembly. With the kind of cooperation, communication and unity that exists, it was inevitable that substantial growth should result. For example, at our January 1974 Assembly, 6 of the 14 districts were not represented... 4 of those 6 because we had no district committee chairman. Total attendance was approximately 76. At the April 1974 Assembly, only 3 districts were not represented, and of those 3, only 2 districts were without district committee chairmen. Total attendance approximately 100. This surely tells us something about the success of your Area officers' efforts to attract!

By the time of the July 1974 Assembly, only one district was not represented and the approximate attendance was again 100. But the BIG PAYOFF is that at the final meeting of the year (Dec. 8 Committeemens' Meeting) ALL 14 DISTRICTS were well represented and we have district committee chairmen in all 14 districts, though two of them were absent from that meeting.

Unfortunately, financial support of the Area has not quite kept pace with the current inflated economy and higher expenses. Now that our Area structure seems to be providing the very important channels of communication to insure that the "conscience" of all A.A. members within its boundaries may be heard, it is time for District Committee Chairmen and Local Committee members to emphasize the responsibility of each group within their jurisdictions to support the services that are necessary to perpetuate this Fellowship. Probably some new GSRs have not previously been aware of the recommendation on page 52 of the A.A. SERVICE MANUAL that their group should be contributing on the following basis after their group expenses have been met:

- 60% to the local Central Office;
- This would be the Harbor Area

C.O., Inland Empire C.O., or Orange County C.O... depending on the location of the group. But it does not include the Los Angeles Central Office because that is in the neighboring Southern California Area. Of course, group autonomy (Tradition 4) will make the decision as to which central offices are to be supported. 30% to the General Service Office in New York (Box 459, Grand Central Station, New York 10017, N.Y.) 10% to the Mid-Southern California Area (P.O. Box 6222, Long Beach, Ca. 90806.

For example, if the group has \$20.00 left over at the end of the month, \$12.00 would go to the local central office; \$6.00 to the General Service Office; & \$2.00 to the Mid-Southern California Area.

As we begin this second year it has become necessary for your officers to regretfully accept the resignation of your secretary, Dorothy E... that is the bad news! The good news is that our former Area Secretary, Trudi H., is now in position to devote the necessary time to do the job for us and is willing to finish out the term until December 31, 1975. We want to express deepest gratitude to Dorothy for a job well done; and in particular to Trudi for coming to our rescue in this manner for the second time within the past five years!

As we look backward in anticipation of moving forward in this New Year, I asked the officers if they would like to make a brief statement about their activities to include in this message... and you know what!!... they were reluctant to do so, preferring to let the record speak. And so I cannot tell you exactly how many hours these beautiful and dedicated people have spent on Area business (they would say "on their own sobriety",) but a look at the "rotation schedule" will give you some idea.

As we talked, Stu seemed to feel that in addition to doing the job for which he was elected, the outstanding experience

he had was chairing an Open Public Meeting in Hemet (District 14) which was remarkably well-attended by the general public and representatives of the press. Jerry told me that this past year has been one of the most exciting and interesting he has experienced since becoming sober, primarily because he has met so many fine, dedicated people. Goldene told me her experiences of the past year have been most rewarding and she feels they have greatly enhanced her growth in A.A. and especially service. She particularly mentioned that it has been beautiful to see the growth and strength of the service structure in increased attendance and interest at the Committee Meetings and Assemblies... and to this, as your Delegate, I can only say AMEN!

And now, in unity, clarity and love, your officers wish you happiness, peace and contentment in 1975...and ever increasing involvement in the TOTAL PROGRAM of Alcoholics Anonymous!
