"The Only Requirement"

No one could ever claim that A.A. is a stranger to controversy, but sometimes an issue arises that could do serious harm to A.A. if not eventually destroy our fellowship. Our fourth tradition states that "each group should be autonomous except in matters affecting other groups or A.A. as a whole." But at what point does autonomy cease being desirable and start to affect other groups and A.A. overall?

Our Fifth Tradition states that "each group has but one primary purpose— to carry its message to the alcoholic who still suffers." But notice that it says "alcoholic" rather than "drug addict" or "chemically dependent person". Many treatment centers and hospitals are now telling their patients that there is no difference between alcoholism and addiction to narcotics, barbiturates, tranquilizers and other addictive drugs.

Graduates of these institutions then continue to foster these misconceptions by "sponsoring" more recent graduates and encouraging narcotic and pill addicts who have no real alcohol problem at all, to call themselves A.A. members and to attend closed A.A. meetings. In many cases this is leading to the formation of so-called "A.A. groups", many of whose members are not alcoholics at all, but who use the group to try to recover from a narcotic or pill addiction.

This violates our Third— Fourth —Fifth and Sixth Traditions. We feel strongly at this point the autonomy of these "groups" and their members is affecting other groups and A.A. as a whole, and could even lead to the collapse of A.A. as a fellowship, unless these misconceptions are corrected. This whole controversial subject is more than adequately covered in the A.A. pamphlet entitled "Problems Other Than Alcohol" by A.A. cofounder Bill W. available from A.A. service office in New York (or your local central office).

We couldn't be more sympathetic with the non-alcoholic drug addict who sincerely wants to recover, and sees A.A.'s astounding record of success with alcoholics. We'll gladly lend you our Twelve Steps and other tools if they'll help you, but we must ask you not to attend our closed meetings under false pretenses, since that can only lead to misunderstanding and disappointment for you, and would divert us alcoholics from our primary purpose, which is to stay sober and help other alcoholics to achieve sobriety.

We must also request that hospitals, treatment centers and counselors refrain from encouraging their non-alcoholic patients to attend closed A.A. meetings under false pretenses. Honesty is one of the basic requirements for recovery, whether from alcoholism or any other addiction.

If you have a genuine alcoholic problem and in addition have become hooked on pills, as has happened to so many of us, you are, of course welcome at any A.A. meeting whether open or closed. We do ask, however, that at meetings you confine your remarks to your alcoholic problem. With recovery from alcoholism, the pill problem will usually take care of itself in due time.

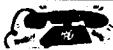

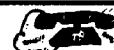

We have received the 1979 year-end statements from GSO, New York, reflecting the group contributions from all Mid-Southern California Area groups which are registered. These are copies of the statements sent to each individual group which has sent a mailing address of a General Service Representative, a secretary or treasurer, or contact-- some mailing address for the group. Many of the groups will not receive their statements because of lack of correct information--- address to which New York can send the receipt for the group contribution.

When mailing a contribution to New York it is essential that the Group Registration number be used. There is an individual number identifying each group in the United States and Canada. In a large metropolitan area there are many groups with identical names (or very similar) and when there are three Easy Does It groups in the same area credit can often be hard to give the correct group. The identification number is the answer. Many group secretaries tell me that they have not received a statement or a receipt for their contribution. The registration for the group must be maintained correctly, reflecting changes in address etc. if NY can be expected to respond.

Please check your statement for any incorrections and send these changes to me or give them to your District Committeeman and they will be made available to the NY office. This is not a function of the local AA Central Office so handle them through your delegate or committeeman, please. It IS necessary that the local Central Office have correct information regarding your group, officers, time and location as well as type of meeting, etc.

I was happy when I received notice that my committee assignment at the Conference in April was Correctional Facilities. I feel comfortable in this committee, not because I feel that I am well informed, but that my experience in service really began in the Hospital and Institutional activity in Harbor Area and Orange County H & I Committees. It contributed greatly to my ability to "accept" what service endeavor requires--- humility, gratitude, patience and so many things which did not come easily or rapidly in my sobriety. Conference committee assignments are for the two years of a delegate's term so I will have an opportunity to learn much.

I have received excellent response from the Questionnaire which has been circulating through the area for the past eight weeks. The questions were all designed to give me a feeling of the people in the program on the questions which will be discussed in New York in April. Many of these deal directly with the experience we, as recovering alcoholics, have had in service in all its aspects. Quite a percentage of returns showed activity in service committee work (General Service, Assembly, Central Office, H&I work, trusted servant positions in groups, personal twelve-step work, conventions, conferences and Roundups. Almost all who have done these things feel that the participation, at whatever level, contributed greatly to their growth in sobriety as well as a personal sense of "belonging" a greater acceptance of responsibility and a better understanding of themselves as well as their spiritual growth.

Other questions had to do with AA's relationship with the treatment facilities, the non-alcoholic engaged in helping in the recovery of alcoholics, the step houses, convalescent hospitals and all outside endeavors in the alcoholic field. All these are an effort to communicate our important efforts at cooperation but not affiliation. We must preserve the traditions and many questions confront us in this type of participation.

Again thanks to you for your cooperation in filling out the Questionnaires. I feel better qualified to be your trusted servant as a result of all you have shared with me. Thanks to your Harbor Area Intergroup Bulletin, the Orange County Lifeline and the Inland Empire Newsletter for printing the Questionnaires in their publications.

The 8th Annual Statewide Hospital & Institution Conference will bring together members of Alcoholics Anonymous who are active in hospital and institutional work.

LET'S BE FRIENDS.....

Cooperation with other organizations and institutions which work in the field of alcoholism will be the topic of the conference.

The theme is "Let's Be Friendly With Our Friends" from the title of an article Bill W. wrote for the Grapevine in 1958.

After discussing the work in alcoholism of the Yale group, the National Council on Alcoholism, the thousands of public and private hospitals, industry, judges, American Medical Association and other Organizations, Bill said, "So let us work alongside these projects of promise to hasten the recovery of those millions who have not yet found their way out. These varied labors do not need our special endorsement; they need only a helping hand

when, as individuals, we can possibly give it."

It was in keeping with Bill W.'s admonishment that Wes F., Dr. C., and Charlie T. appeared before the Northern California H & I general meeting in 1972 and proposed holding a state conference in which A.A. members involved in institutional work throughout the state would meet and cooperate with the professionals in hospitals, penal institutions, correctional facilities, courts etc.

The first H & I Conference of California was held in Stockton in 1972 with about 485 persons in attendance. The second annual conference was held in Bakersfield in 1973 and the third, postponed 1 year until 1975, was held in Fresno, the site of every conference since then.

The purpose then and now was to give AA members the opportunity to meet with professionals in various fields once a year to

learn how we can cooperate with them in helping the alcoholics who are confined in institutions and hospital treatment facilities.

The conference has grown in size from those 485 the first year to 780 last year which was held during the year's first big gasoline crunch and gasoline was virtually unobtainable in Los Angeles and San Francisco.
