MESSAGE FROM YOUR DELEGATE

THIS IS A PARTICULARLY busy season for your delegate this year. The printouts for over 600 groups which must be corrected for the 1981 Western United States AA Directory arrived and have been distributed to the committeemen in the various districts. Many of them are coming back to me which requires that my master file cards be corrected and the printouts be returned to New York. This often requires many telephone calls for missing information, errors etc. I have sent quite a few in to the NY office and they all must be received there by January 15th if your group is to appear in the Directory. We are all making diligent efforts to have this information as accurate as reasonably possible but remember when you see the 1981 Directory there will have been many changes which could not be reflected at this time. Bear with us and please accept our sincere thanks for your cooperation in this work. The third quarterly group financial statements have also arrived and have been (or ore being) distributed by the committeemen. If your group is registered in New York and has a GSR, a contact or even a mailing address for the group on the registration record in New York, a copy of this financial statement was mailed and you should have received them in late November.

A perusal (and computation) of these statements show that slightly over half of the 600 groups in the Mid-Southern Assembly area made a contribution this year. The statement reflects the first nine months of 1980 total contributions, and I am proud that the percentage is that high. One responsibility of a Group is to be self-supporting and we feel that another is to be part of A.A. as a whole by contributing under the 60-30-10 plan. An inform ed group conscisnce usually makes this possible. Did your group contribute?

The Questionnaires are now in your hands and we hope that response is as good this year as it has been in the past. The Conference Agenda is a good one, we feel, and our questions on Inventory largely deal with the group level. Many groups have possibly never investigated a Group Inventory but those who have many times find that a number of things can be incorporated into the regular participation of group members, other than purely podium participation. This is especially true of study and discussion groups. We anticipate a great deal of enjoyment in sharing at the Pacific Regional Assembly in Anchorage, Alaska February 27–28, March 1. Both Clara and myself will give you reports on this experience and we thank you for the opportunity and privilege to serve in this capacity.

The Symposium of Service is in the immediate future and will be held Frbruary 21,;0:00 AM to 4:00 PM at the Immaculate Conception Church, 1090 North LaCedena, Colton. This is a highlight annually in the Mid-Southern California Area and you are invited.
