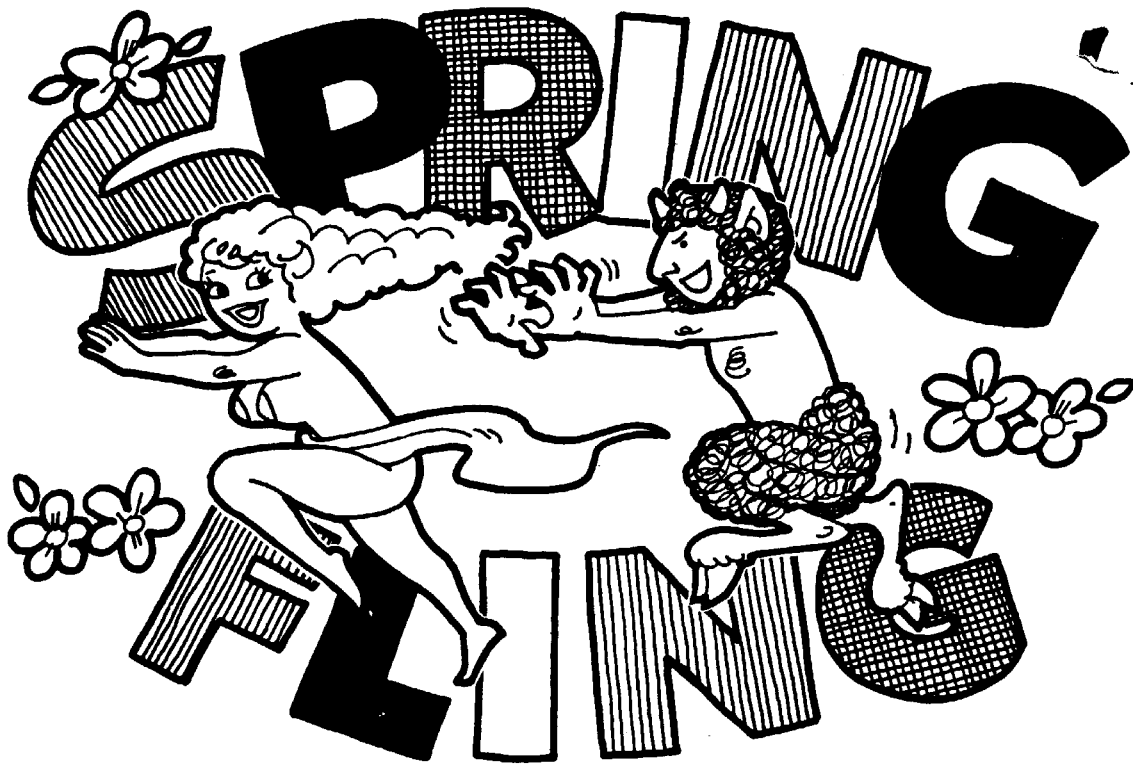

HOW GROUPS CAN BECOME STRONGER AND BETTER

The group is the center of the A. A. Fellowship, and will remain healthy and vital if its members follow the steps and 12 Traditions. If the group is solid, the sobriety of the members will be solid, and the newcomer will sense this.

The basic message of AA, as embodied in the 12 Steps, makes the program work, and the group must reflect this dedication and commitment. It is up to us as individuals to make sure our group does reflect all that is good of the Fellowship. Whatever I do in my group has an effect. If I am careless with A. A. Traditions, the group is careless. If I shun 12th Step calls, the group is not reaching its collective hand out to those who need help. Once again, I'm reminded of an early member's saying, "Unity begins with you." In order to understand and improve the function and purpose of our groups, a group inventory seems essential. The group is the means for transmitting personal recovery, so its quality will always be important. It is imperative we make time to take these fearless and continuing group inventories.

It is important to review how we in the group think about the basics of A. A., and how we propose to put into action our primary purpose. Are we carrying the message in every reasonable way we can think of? Are we reaching out to the community with ample information about what AA is--and what AA is not? Are we committed to sponsorship? Do we give the newcomer telephone numbers and encouragement?

We here today have a special message to share with the newcomer--the tremendous benefits we have enjoyed in our individual sobriety due to our service involvement in A. A. Setting up service workshops devoted to the group and group activities is a method of instructing AA members about the purpose and function of groups. The repetition of basics is sometimes forgotten these days in our efforts to brighten up or modernize. Let's not forget, every time the door opens and a new member comes in, he or she has never heard the 12 Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous read, or felt the newfound love of its membership. It may be 1980 but our common illness, alcoholism, is the same as it was in 1935. Terry S., Washington Area Delegate. (Reprinted with permission of A. A. FROM NEW YORK Central Office comes mail which is my favorite reading for it provides me with an ever more interesting compendium of all that goes on at our world center of Alcoholics Anonymous. The wide spectrum of activities is fascinating. And this past month has been no exception.

I received the 1980 International AA Directory (outside U.S. and Canada) Summer Edition. Listed are one hundred and thirty-four countries in which there are AA Groups. From Algeria to Zimbabwe Rhodesia. This Directory lists several countries with large AA populations only by General Service Offices, Central Offices and Intergroups rather than by groups individually because of the rapid AA growth. These offices can be contacted directly by a personal visit, phone call or letter for accurate information about AA groups.

In countries with no established office to provide service, AA groups and lone members are listed by city and town in the International Directory.

An additional help to the traveler, English-speaking groups within non-English speaking countries are listed. This, to further assist the traveler who has a desire to find AA wherever in the world he or she may be.

ALSO IN THE MAIL recently was the Report on the Sixth World Service Meeting of Alcoholics Anonymous held in the Harrison Conference Center, Glen Cove, New York- June 27-30, 1980 at which the delegates from 24 countries, as well as staff from GSO in New York City attended. Thirty-four delegates expressed their ideas and opinions on matters of concern to AA around the world. The theme "Service- the Heart of AA", provided scope for enthusiastic participation by all in attendance. Presentations were: Future of AA Worldwide, Finance, Relationship of Central Offices/Intergroups and the National Service Structure and Leadership in AA. The committees reporting were on Agenda, Literature/Publishing, Policy/Admissions/Finance, Working With Others, Site Committee and Floor Actions. One floor action sends the Seventh World World Service Meeting to Mexico City to be held October 14-18, 1982.

Another Service Activity from GSO in New York which sends information on worldwide Twelfth Step Work is that from the Loners-Internationalists. This comes to us in a regular news sheet which is "An AA Meeting for Loners, Internationalists, and other AA's who cannot attend regular AA meetings."

Included are messages from AA members from around the world, as an example the January/February 1981 issue has messages from Kenya, East Africa; Forres, Scotland; Christa Trenz, Italy; Brazil; Somalia, East Africa; La Salle, Quebec; a loner aboard the SS Sacramento; Fraderikstad, Norway; Girdwood, Alaska; Sydney, Australia; Yong Yae Ri, Korea; Lyon, France and San Jose, Costa Rica, among others. All participated in the "Meeting" and shared their experience, strength and hope. In truth, we are genuinely international in Alcoholics Anonymous. We found the name of one of our General Service people here in the Mid-Southern California Area listed as a Loner Sponsor.

By the time this appears we shall be ready to go to Anchorage, Alaska for the 14th Annual Pacific Region AA Service Assembly, Feb. 27, 28, March 1, Clara C., Bob B., Ellery S., Frank S., and myself will be there from the Mid-Southern California Area and we will all bring back reports of all that transpires. The Symposium of Service will be over and we hope many of you were able to attend in Colton.

The last Assembly was very well attended and we feel that a great deal was accomplished. Thank all of you for your fine work in this area and Clara and I extend personal thanks for your loyal support.
