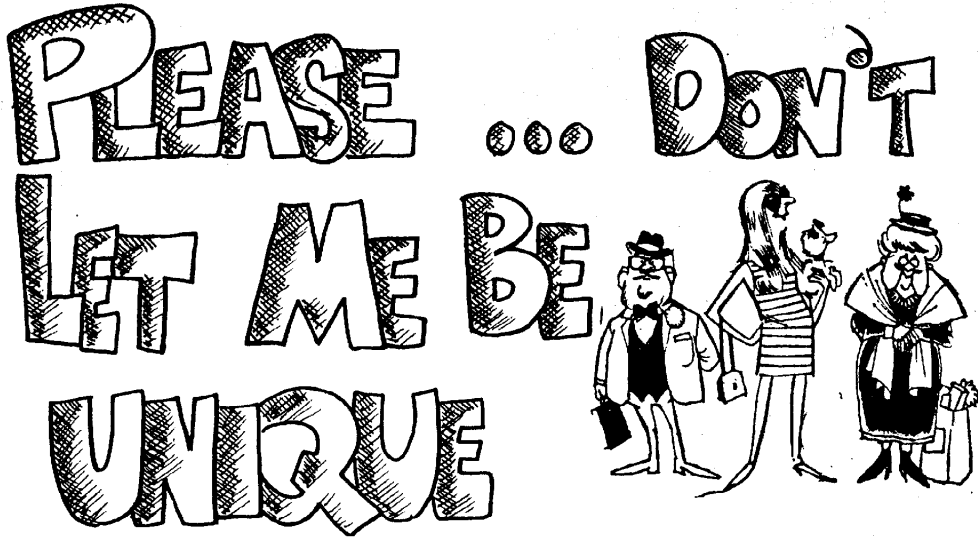
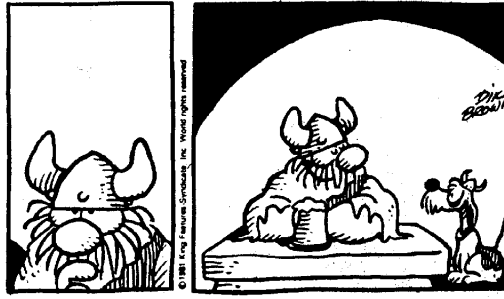
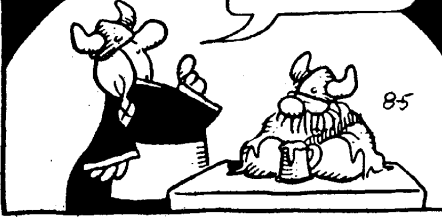

It was a disease of denial, so everyone ran around being okay on the outside and full of fear and inadequacy on a deeper level. It is only in retrospect that I am able to see this. I thought I was a normal teenager until I slowly sold out all of the things that I held dear. Until all of the people I had tried to love and invest in were gone. Seeing these truths, my truths, makes all of those days worth it.

I have always tried so desperately to be special. The image I had of myself was one of a kind, loving, wonderful, pretty, confident, unselfish young woman. Everything I did was to hurt myself or another person and slowly deplete my supply of self worth. Street people live on lies. They must.

One day in 1977 I was awakened by a huge swallow of self. The lies stopped working. I had to look at me! Somehow I was given the strength to walk through the truth one piece at a time. Today the most unique thing I have to offer is that I try on a daily basis to be one among many. Sometimes gracefully and sometimes kicking. I have a story to share with other people that may help them to keep on walking. I am learning of unconditional love and real self worth. The kind that is not chemically induced. I am learning what it is to be a friend, daughter and employee thru trial and error. I walk with hope, joy and a bit of excitement because I know that anything can happen. On the other hand, I have not surpassed being human, for I still get scared, angry and frustrated, but I can also share these things with people who walk next to me and if its okay for me, its okay for them.

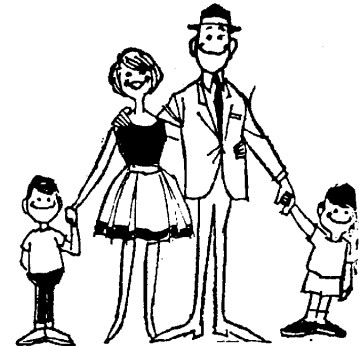
" PERHAPS AND IF ONLYS "

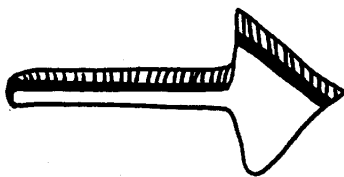

For The NEWCOMER Reality

For those of us in A.A.,
reality is a difficult thing,
without it there is nothing
valid on which to base our
lives. With it, there is a
mountain of truth, honesty,
and hope for all of us to
climb, never ceasing and ever-
lasting.

Reality, therefore must exist
for us to remain a part of
an ultimately real world.
Reality for me is facing
the fact that I am a very
sick person, emotionally,
spiritually and mentally.
Taking a good, hard look at
myself is never easy, but
then little of life is easy.
More often than not, I tend
to fantasize, always making
myself much more kind, under-
standing and honest than I
really am.

My first experience with
reality hit me hard and put
me to the floor on my face.
It wasn't until I had almost
three months on the program
that I came to grips with
my illness.

I had suddenly forgotten all
my factual reasons for being
here and had started to play
games with myself, my sponsor
and my new found friends.
But the games I was playing
were deadly to someone with
my disease.

I began to think I really
didn't have a problem, I told
myself I stayed because of
the other people, so I could
help all those poor, sick
alcoholics I had met, (Not
remembering I was one.)
I said I stayed because I did
not want them to think I was
a quitter (I just wasn't
like them, but they wouldn't
understand).

I stayed because I was des-
perately afraid of making a
mistake -if I left where,
where would I go!
I played for awhile, daring
my own insanity to take over
and it did.

Slowly and subtly at first,
I didn't even see it until it
was too late, not until I
wanted a drink (or drugs) so
bad that I made an attempt
on my own life, (a feeble one
because I knew deep down that
I didn't want to die, I just
needed an excuse to take that

first drink or pill.)
I slipped, had a fleeting
moment of sanity and called
a fellow A.A.
Today I'm back, but with many
new realizations:
1. I am a very sick alcoholic
person.
2. If I want to stay sober
then it has to be for me not
for friends, family and not
for all those other poor,
sick alcoholics.
3. I know that Alcoholics
Anonymous is where I belong,
because there is nowhere else
for me to go. (Except to die.)
4. I make no mistakes about
the power alcohol has over my
life, and I know without the
shadow of a doubt that A.A.
and my Higher Power can help
me overcome my disease.
That is my reality today.
My sponsor tells me that
experience is mine to keep,
and I hope I never forget
my experience with alcoholic
insanity as a sober member
of A.A.

YOUR DELEGATE has spent this summer traveling over a great deal of the Mid-Southern California Area, attending meetings, committee meetings, district meetings and H&I gatherings. I have been called on to share pertaining to the program, its traditions, policies and practices under any and all challenges. And there are many.

Most of our "situations," which we sometimes think are grave challenges, usually require only a calm appraisal based on good judgement, a liberal attitude and the ability to control our emotions, particularly where it involves tolerance.

In most cases that arise leading to confrontations about the interpretation of the Big Book, traditions, concepts and guide lines, our sober leaders can handle these situations. We are challenged by newcomers who come to us through different avenues leading ultimately to sobriety. The dually addicted who come to us admitting to our disease we should, and in most cases do, receive with a warm welcome and make an effort to fully share our A.A. program. When anyone talks in meetings extensively about problems other than alcohol it becomes the chairman or secretary of the meetings duty to ask the speaker to talk about our mutual problem as it affects his or her life or refrain from speaking. Many times it becomes the responsibility of a sober attendant at the meeting to speak up and point out that our primary purpose, individually and as a group, is to help suffering alcoholics recover from our disease. Tact, common sense and an attitude of calm humility will often turn a possible uncomfortable situation into one of sharing in understanding.

We have heard of people with problems "other than alcohol" infiltrating and taking over whole groups. We have not personally seen this. If and when this occurs, we feel that it is the fault of the group itself for not making the group conscience a vital part of the fellowship but letting it lie dormant. The ultimate authority in service of any kind in A.A. is the voice of the group conscience acting in the light of the primary purpose as stated above..

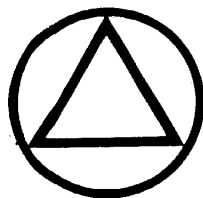
