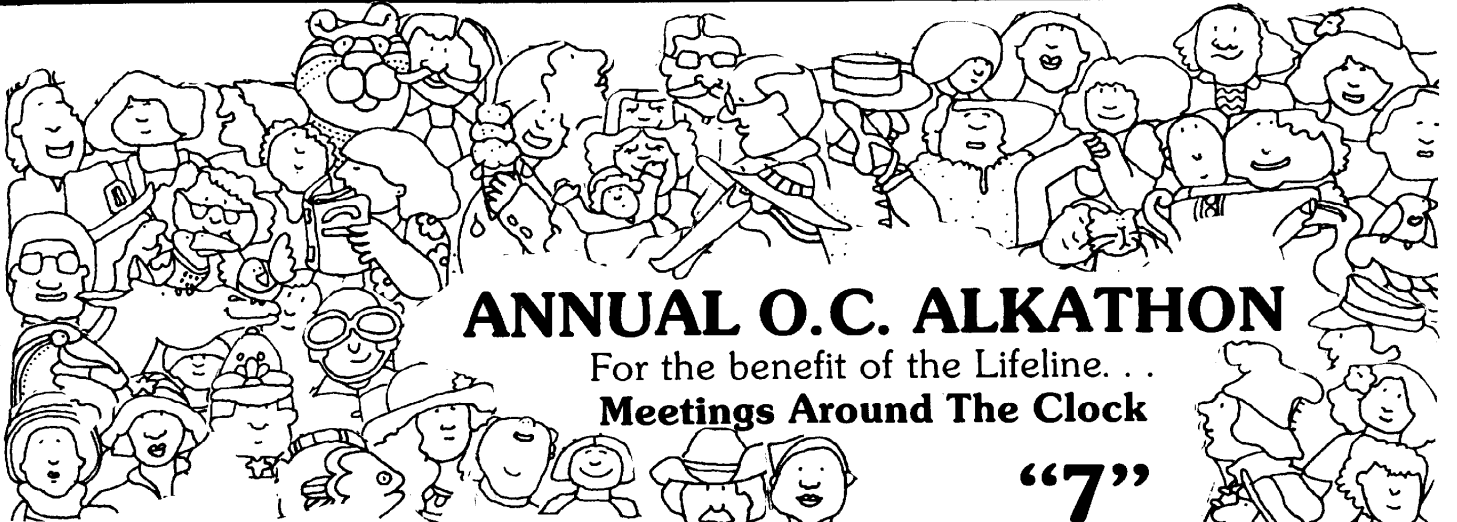

REBORN

It's really been humilating so many times in A.A. having a 30 year old (or so . . .) body and a 3 year old emotional system. When they say in the Big Book, that we were **REBORN**—they weren't kidding. I had no idea when I started A.A. that "SOBER"—everything I attempted to do and whatever I had to walk through was a first!

Before A.A. I'd been dying a day at a time, desperately holding on to the small fragments of something good out there. It was futile. I couldn't see good in people, they were phoney, inconsistant undependable liars. I couldn't see good in nature—it was polluted. It wasn't in work cause they never seemed to care anyway. Relationships were impossible and God was definately no where to be found.

I was a periodic drunk, daily drug user, compulsive overeater coupled with a superior attitude/inferiority complex, dawning the outward image of "Sister Mary Marter" and wearing banners that said "VICTIM, VICTIM, VICTIM". Ooh what a lovely creature I was at the doorsteps of A.A. I was totally dependent on alcohol, drugs and jive to survive.

People said, "Keep coming back" and my secret heart replied, "Like Hell I will, you ain't gettin' me!" I was so scared. They told me I was not different and I thought either they all needed glasses or a good shot of sensitivity training. They talked about program, which I knew I would never have. . . you see I couldn't even memorize the Serenity Prayer. They said "Keep it Simple" and I knew there was a deeper meaning. They shouted, "Feelings aren't fact", and I felt they were nuts. So after this deep analyzation, why stay around? Why surrender? Why take direction? Why? (Which was my middle name)

I knew there was no place for me to go. I was finished, washed up and ready to die. Somehow, though, a Higher Power, the gift of willingness and faith or hope was displayed in those around me. They knew where I was coming from. We talked the same language. It seemed people in A.A. told the truth to the best of their ability. I saw some kind, healthy faces and bright eyes. They invited me to stay. I had been kicked out of other places and they were asking me to stay!

I didn't know who I was, but they knew what I was and where I had come from and where I could go.

So A.A., from that time has been my safe harbour, a refuge from the crazies, and a sanctuary that has sheltered me long enough to connect with a Higher Power who has given me the gift of sobriety.

. . . As we felt new power flow in, as we enjoyed peace of mind, as we discovered we could face life

successfully, as we became conscious His presence, we began to lose our fear of today, tomorrow, or the hereafter. WE WERE REBORN.

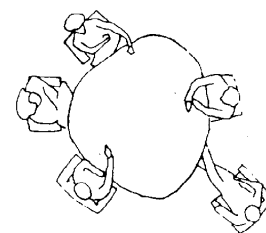

Reality

Around the Tables



AROUND THE TABLES, we search for answers — not only to the problems evolved from our drinking days, but also to the current problems of living in reality. For me, living in reality means accepting the responsibilities of the moment, rather than those of the future, which may never come. It means experiencing happiness now, instead of expecting it tomorrow. As long as I stay immersed in the now, I can meet and deal with its problems. When I leave the now in an attempt to solve future problems, then I am back in the old role so aptly described in Chapter Five of the Big Book — trying to "run the whole show" and do God's work for Him.

If I am to practice AA principles, then I must do so today. I ask God to help me avoid daydreaming as a solution, since woolgathering doesn't help me get into action *now*. Waiting for conditions to clear so I can be happy, get a job, find a mate, etc., produces nothing but more waiting. I must remember "Easy Does It," but that does not mean inaction. "Easy Does It" implies action, but with some rationality.

The solutions to problems today are available to us today. Granted, the resolution may not take place until later, but it is what we do today that will determine that resolution. Thank God for AA and the development of the program to give us lives that are so much better than our dreams.

What was my life like before I first heard the word sponsor? Life was lonely. I was seeking. At first I was seeking a closer contact with God - what I ended up with is A.A.

A.A. is sponsorship! It is one alcoholic sharing his experience, his strengths, and his hopes with another alcoholic.

I am no different from every other recovering alcoholic. I am fearful of rejection and so I rationalize why I don't have a sponsor. I tell myself there is no need - I can do it (get sober) all by myself. I am self-sufficient. I will not trust anyone -after, all I've only been hurt by people, I'll go it alone. I am defiant. And besides I don't know how to ask someone to be my sponsor. I am insecure.

Inspite of all these feelings I ask, "Will you be my sponsor" I'm willing to try it (staying sober) someone else's way. I'm risking - I'm trusting - I am surrendering!

That surrender is the beginning. It says to me that I am willing to listen and learn from someone who was in my position. I am being open minded. And to be open minded I need to be honest. Honest with myself, with my sponsor, and with my fellows.

I am no longer alone, no longer alienated. I am relieved of my self-imposed prison. I no longer need to choose imprisonment as the only way out. I can look to my sponsor for direction, organization and guidance. We can walk-thru many things - I don't need to go it (stay sober) alone. My sponsor can show me how to face anything - by her example. I can share my secrets with my sponsor. I can share feelings of inadequacy, guilt and sadness and know that I will get the best answer.

Belonging to A.A. is like being nurtured and held. There are no big deals and one of the reasons is: SPONSORSHIP.

**Pup bites 'bullet,'
inspires alcoholics**

He grew up around a tavern on Chicago's West Side and started drinking at an early age.

Then one day last November, while drunk, he was struck by a truck while crossing the street in front of a bar. He suffered internal injuries and a broken leg.

He underwent surgery to repair the internal injuries, and a pin was placed in his leg. But the anesthetic triggered convulsions, a common symptom of alcoholism. He was turned over to a suburban alcoholism treatment center.

come to be called because of his long whiskers, was born a stray and apparently grew up near a tavern where patrons regularly gave him handouts, including beer. He was sick, undernourished and often drunk, Abbey officials said.

The victim, a 9-month-old, black-and-white mongrel puppy, is sober and healthy these days, and has become something of an inspiration for recovering alcoholics at the Abbey, a private treatment facility in Winfield, Ill.

"He's helped save a lot of lives," said one patient, Tramp, as the mixed terrier has

Residents and employees of the Abbey nursed him to health after the accident, with medication, extra vitamins and exercise, by order of a veterinarian.

Now he's returning the favor. Walk in the door of the Abbey and Tramp comes running. He tags along as one patient jogs each morning, curls up in bed with a different person each night and plays softball during the recreation period.

He even attends group and family counseling sessions, therapy workshops, lectures and films along with the other patients.

"He comforts you, whether by crawling up on your lap or checking you out with his nose,"

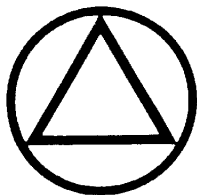

INTEREST CENTERS IN THE LOCAL AA community at this time every two years as the regular election of officers is conducted in October. The delegate elected for the next two years will be a member of Panel 32 at the Thirty-second annual meeting of the General Service Conference of Alcoholics Anonymous. This will be held in April 1982 in New York City.

Officers to be chosen are Delegate, Alternate Delegate, Chairperson, Secretary, and Treasurer, all to be elected for two year terms. If our recollection of history is correct, we will be electing the eleventh slate of assembly officers since MSCA became an area of the Conference. Delegates have included Art B., Joe K., Tom A., Warren S., Ellery S., John McA., Genevieve L., Jerry F., Goldene L., and your present delegate.

Those eligible to serve are the GSR's from the approximately six hundred groups which make up our Assembly Area (unfortunately they is a very small representation for that number of groups), the nineteen District Committeemen, four of the present officers of the Assembly—the present delegate in office cannot succeed himself or herself, the chairmen of the five Hospital and Institutional Committees and the Chairmen of the six Intergroup Central Office Committees.

The third legacy procedure is followed in the election of the delegate and is a unique type of choosing. We quote from the Manual:

"All members of the committee are eligible for delegate; the chairperson asks whether any are unable to serve, and withdraws those names. (This is what makes up nomination). Remaining names are posted on a blackboard. (In rare cases, the meeting, by a majority vote, agrees to accept additional nominations.) All GSR's and committeemembers of the area who are present cast written ballots, one choice to a ballot. The tally for each candidate is posted on the blackboard.

The first candidate to receive TWO-THIRDS of the total vote is elected.

After the second ballot (assuming no candidate receives the necessary two-thirds on the first ballot), any candidate having less than one fifth of the total vote will be withdrawn automatically, except that the TWO TOP CANDIDATES must remain. (In case there are ties for second place, the top candidate and tied second place candidates remain.)

After the third ballot, candidates with less than one-third of the total vote will be withdrawn automatically, except that the TWO TOP CANDIDATES must remain. (In case there are ties for second place, the top candidate and tied second place candidate remain.) A fourth ballot is conducted. After the fourth ballot if no candidate has two-thirds of the total vote, the chairperson asks for a motion, second and majority of hands on conducting a fifth and final ballot. If this motion is defeated, balloting is over and we go to the hat immediately. If the motion carries, a fifth and final ballot will be conducted. If no election occurs by this time the chairperson announces the choice will be made by the lot (from the hat). At this point, balloting usually involves only the top two or three candidates.

Lots are then drawn by the teller, and the first one "out of the hat" becomes the delegate."

This final procedure happened two years ago. It is quite an emotional experience. Be sure to come to the next election assembly—it is not boring, nor is it "politics!"
